

At St George's CE Primary, our Art and Design scheme of work aims to engage, inspire and challenge pupils, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design as well as finding out about relevant artists. Our lessons are planned sequentially across the primary phase and build upon the skills the children have already developed.



IMPLEMENTATION

- A sequence of planned, practical lessons across each year group with carefully planned progressive skills and knowledge with five strands of; making skills, generating ideas, formal elements, knowledge of artists and evaluating running throughout each unit.
- Sketchbooks used to document ideas throughout KS1 and 2
- A knowledge organiser which outlines knowledge including vocabulary which is selected at appropriate levels for each year group.
- Opportunities for children to experiment with different materials and look at a range of different artists
- Discrete teaching of skills which build and develop unit upon unit
- Support for children to allow all to meet the requirements of the National Curriculum.
- Links to the wider world to develop children's cultural capital.
- Lessons fully scaffold and support essential and age appropriate sequenced learning
- Enrichment opportunities such as educational visits, workshops and visiting artists
