IMPLEMENTATION

- Low stake engaging quizzes and assessment for learning opportunities to track pupil attainment.

INTENT

Our Spanish curriculum intends to:

- Develop a growing knowledge of Spanish vocabulary and structures.
- Inspire learners' knowledge of Spanish culture.
- Introduce learners to a new phonic system to develop good pronunciation.
- Develop oracy skills.
- Enhance listening skills and language learning behaviour.
- Engender an appreciation that cultures are different but also have similarities.
- Teach skills that can be applied in other languages.
- Ensure that pupils are ready to learn a language at KS3 as confident resilient learners.

IMPACT

We measure the impact of our curriculum through the following methods.

- Assessment for Learning self-assessment grids.
- Marking of work to see progress in listening, reading, writing and reading.
- Enrichment days and opportunities
- Celebrating successes of those who let their light shine through languages.
