As I have explained previously – there are new guidelines for schools regarding attendance.

- Please make sure you have given the school office your most up to date contact details – pop in, call 01732 882401 or email reception@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk
- The school gates open at 8.40am but classroom doors are closed at 8.55am as registration has closed and children are heading to worship. If your child arrives after the gates have been closed you will need to sign them in at the school office providing a reason so attendance and punctuality can be accurately recorded. School attendance data is now shared daily with the Department of Education.
- If you have any concerns or worries the <u>class teacher</u> should be your first point of contact
- To ensure we are looking after teacher's well-being and allowing them evenings to be with their own families please note that dojo messages will not be responded to outside of school hours (8.00am and 5.30pm) and may take up to 48hrs
