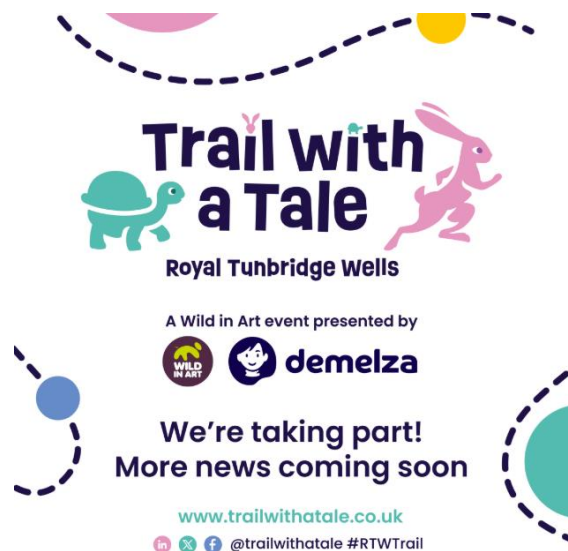


Christian Vision

Year 6 - Religion: Humanism; **Big question:** What is humanism?

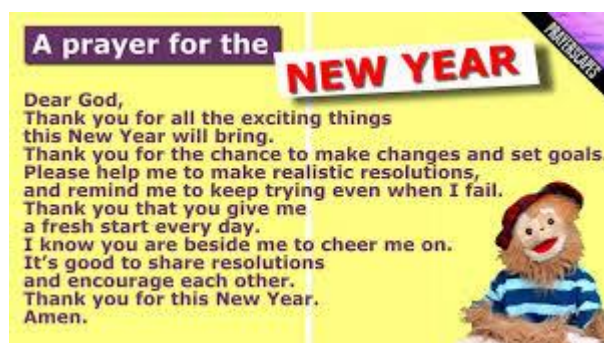
