### Christian Values



Our Christian Value this term is **forgiveness**. We talk about forgiveness and what it looks like in Worship, before connecting it to our own lives.

### RE topics for this term



We continue to use 'Understanding Christianity' resources to support the teaching of Christianity. Through the year, we are required by law to teach 2/3 Christianity and 1/3 other faiths and practices.

Year 6 - Religion: Judaism Big Question: What does it mean to be Jewish in Britain today? Religion: Christianity; Concept: Salvation; Big Question: What difference does the resurrection make for Christians? (Short Unit)
