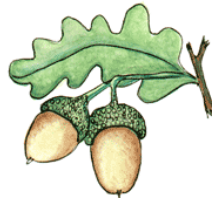
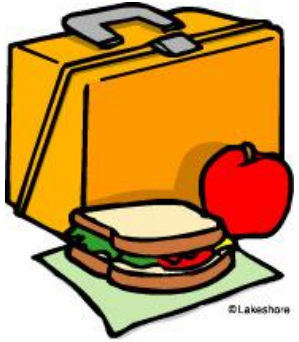
Your child will start at St George's CE Primary School on a part time basis.

## School Dinners

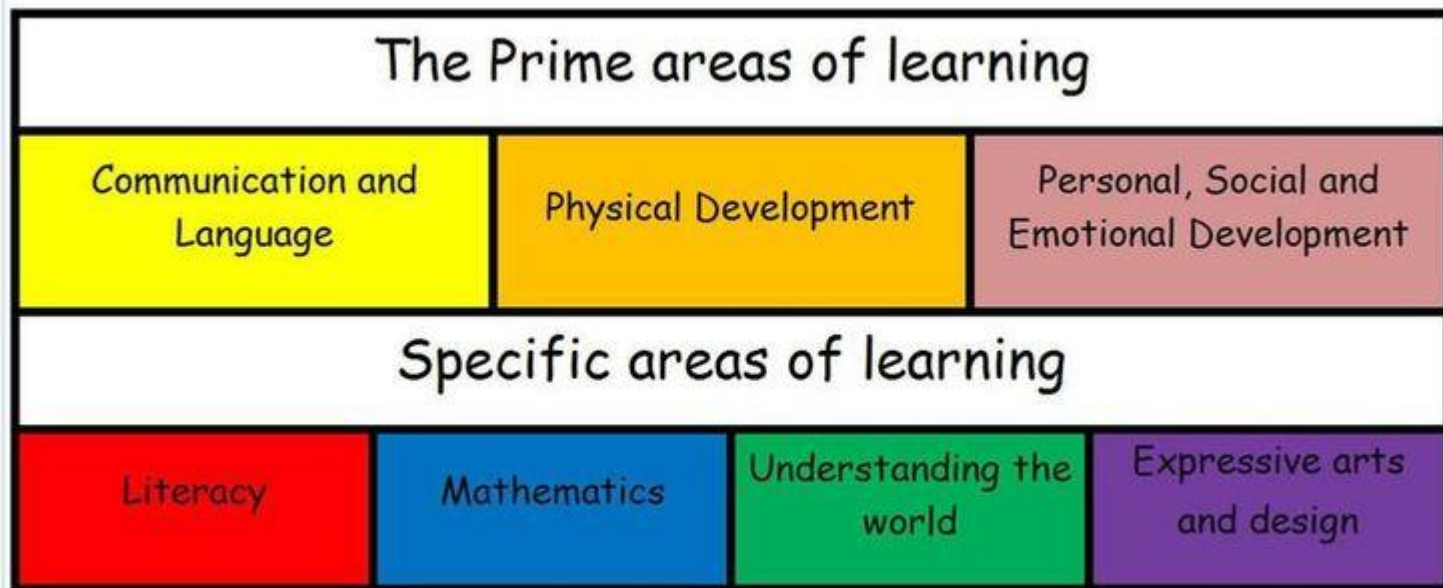
\*School dinners are free and made in our onsite kitchen.

\*Your child can pick and choose the days they have a school dinner.

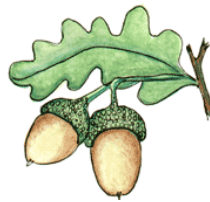


# A typical Day in Oak Class

- \* Reception is part of 'Early Years' or 'Foundation Stage' in the curriculum and leads on from nursery/ pre-school education.
- \* Learning through 'play' is the basis of the curriculum.
- \* In reception your child will be working towards 'Early Learning Goals'
- \* The Early Learning Goals cover 7 Areas of Learning



Staff will carry out regular observations and assessments on your child to monitor their learning and ensure that they make progress through the year.



# School Uniform

# PE

All jewellery must be removed for PE.

Your child will need to have PE kit in school in a named draw string bag.

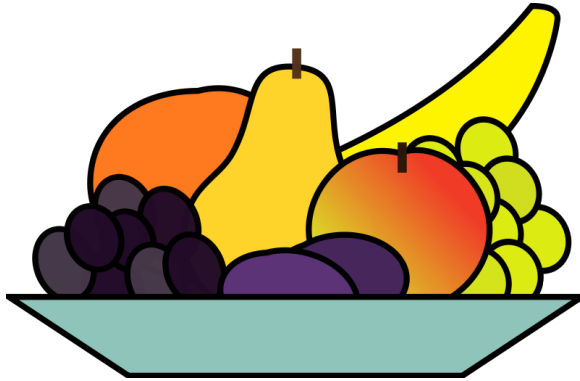
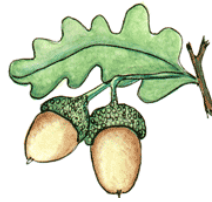
All of your child's belongings need to be **CLEARLY NAMED**

It can be distressing for your child if they cannot find their own things.

All of the children in the class, indeed the school, wear the same uniform.

If you mark your child's clothes with a marker or ballpoint pen, please check them regularly





**Snack**

**Water**

Please provide your child with a named bottle of water to bring into school every day and taken home at the end of school to be refilled. These can be purchased from the school office for £1.50 each.

The children will have access to their water bottles throughout the day.  
**NO JUICE PLEASE.**

**Milk**

Your child can receive free school milk up until their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday. You will need to register online if you require this (see enclosed leaflet).

KS1 children are also given a cup of milk every afternoon in class.







# Absence from school

Please do not send your child back to school until they have been free of sickness for 24 hours or diarrhoea for 48 hours.
